Advance Directive Information

GlobalHealth complies with Oklahoma law and Medicare requirements concerning Advance Directives. An Advance Directive is a written document that may include a living will, appointment of a health care proxy, or both.

Specific Rights:

- You have the right to make decisions concerning your medical care, including the right to accept or refuse medical or surgical treatment, and the right to have an Advance Directive for health care. GlobalHealth will not refuse care or discriminate against you based on whether or not you have an Advance Directive.
- 2. You have the right to receive information concerning Advance Directives.
- 3. Your health care providers will maintain documentation in your current record whether or not you have an Advance Directive.
- 4. You have the right to file a complaint if your health care provider does not comply with state laws concerning Advance Directives.
